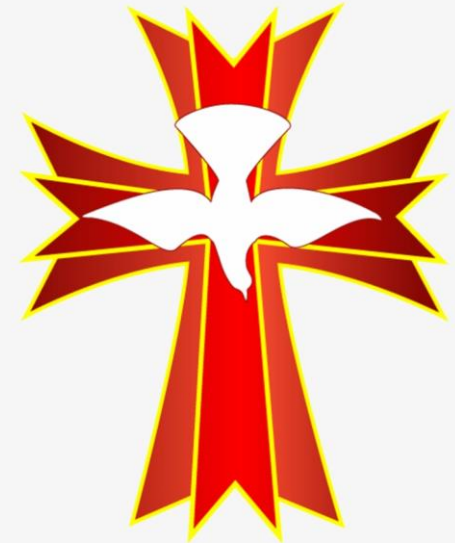

THE SPIRIT, THE NEW LAW OF THE CHRISTIAN (Pentecost Sunday)

The first reading and the Gospel present the descent of the Spirit. It is the same event presented differently. The stories of St. Luke and St. John complement each other and teach us that the Spirit is the new law, the force that leads mankind to do good, from within the heart. THE Spirit is the source of unity, it pulls down all barriers, and wherever it arrives, it destroys sin. The second reading is a consequence of the presence of the Spirit in a community. Every member is enriched by the gift of the same Spirit, gifts that must not be a source of competition but must be put at the service of unity.

Las historias de San Lucas y San Juan se complementan entre sí y nos enseñan que el espíritu es la nueva ley, la fuerza que lleva a la humanidad a hacer el bien, desde dentro del corazón. EL espíritu es la fuente de la unidad, derrite todas las barreras, y dondequiera que llegue, destruye el pecado. La segunda lectura es una consecuencia de la presencia del espíritu en una comunidad. Todo miembro se enriquece con el don del mismo espíritu, dones que no deben ser una fuente de competencia, sino que deben ser puesto en el servicio de la unidad.

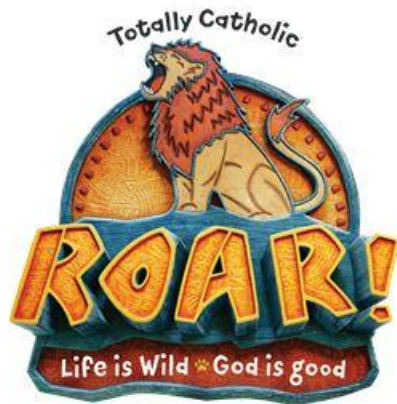
